S3 ASSESSMENTS

In the week beginning 7th March, S3 pupils will be sitting assessments in the Hall. They will have one timed assessment per subject and we will also be running the SNSA assessments (the ones which are taken in P1, P4, P7 and S3) towards the end of the week.

We introduced this Assessment Week a few years ago in response to senior students telling us that they would have appreciated an opportunity to experience the formal setting of the Hall before sitting their S4 Prelims.

So, these S3 assessments are mostly experiential but they might also help with subject choices for S4 where a decision has to be made between two subjects.

Subject teachers will be sharing details of the nature of the assessment with pupils and Support for Learning staff will provide additional support where this is required.
